

Build your own 'Ron's Gone Wrong'-inspired B*Bot



Celebrate the release of 20th Century Studios and Locksmith Animation's 'Ron's Gone Wrong' by designing and making your very own papercraft B*Bot!

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Colour and create a design for your B*Bot (or keep it plain if you want to).
- 2 Cut out your B*Bot using a pair of scissors along all of the solid black lines (ask an adult if you need help with this).
- 3 Fold along all of the dotted lines (this is called 'scoring').

You'll need:

- > Scissors
- > Adhesive (Glue Stick or Double-Sided Tape)
- > Colouring Pencils/Pens to add a design to your B*Bot



- 4 Starting with the tabs labelled 'A' apply a small amount of adhesive (e.g. using a glue stick or double-sided tape).
- 5 The piece should fold and slot nicely underneath the next section, press firmly to allow the adhesive to stick.
- 6 Repeat this process with tabs B, C, D, E and F.
- 7 Now join the two sides together by sticking tab G to other side of the body.
- 8 Repeat the same actions that you used on the top half now on the bottom half with tabs H, I, J, K, L and M.
- 9 Now it's time to add your arms and wheels, apply a small amount of adhesive to the back of the wheels and stick them to the bottom sides of your B*Bot.

- 10 To install the arms, fold along the dotted lines and apply a small amount of adhesive to the small tabs and attach these to the side of your B*Bot (try to line the top of them up with the eyes and mouth).
